



The Unikum Family App – A Guide for Parents and Guardians

Log into the app:

Download the app Unikum Family

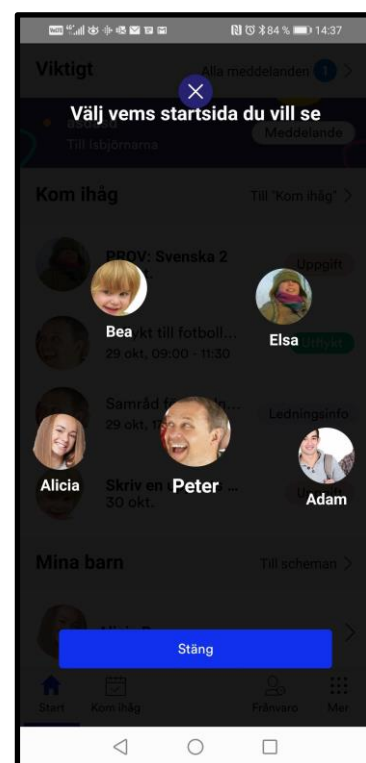
- Log in with your Bank-ID
- If you do not have an active Bank-ID you must then contact your preschool/school



Homepage

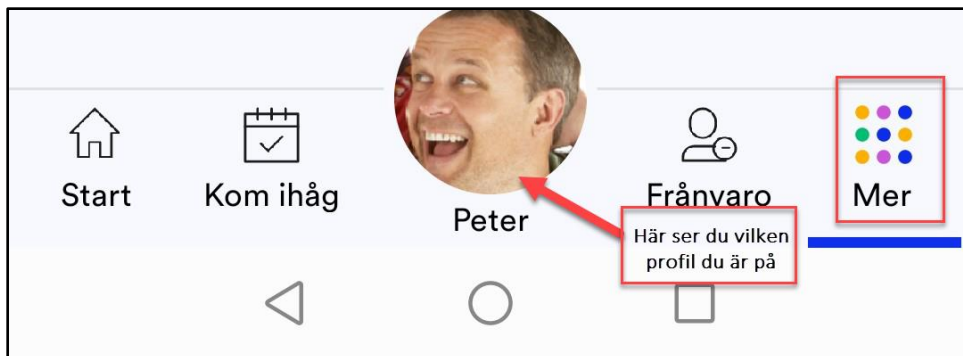
You can choose if you want to see information for all your children at once or one at a time.

On your homepage you will see a collected overview of any messages, reminders, and classes for all of your children in the Unikum system.



To see your information:

- Go in on your personal profile
- Click on the icon "more" – you will see it in the top right corner
- Go to the header marked "profile"
- Here you can see all of your information and edit it accordingly





What can I find under these headings?

Messages

Here you will find all the information and messages that your preschool/school has sent out. If a message is particularly important it will be mark as such with bold writing.

Reminders

Here you will find all the dates that your preschool/school has chosen to mark. This could be, for example, that the school is closed for teacher training that day, that there is a planned school trip, or an allocated parent-teacher meeting. You can even subscribe to having these dates synced with your personal calendar. [Read more on how to do so here.](#)

My child's learning

Here you will find anything uploaded by your preschool, school, class teacher, or afterschool club concerning your child's learning or development, whether that be individually or as part of a group.

Absence

Under "absence" you can report that your child will be away for a whole day or even part of the day. This feature is connected to the system used by preschools, known as Tempus, and the primary years program (Swedish grades 1 – 9), Skola24.

In the app you can even see your child's class schedule should they go in the primary years program or to a compulsory school for children with learning disabilities.

More

Under "more" you can access other features of the Unikum system, for example: future assignments, parent-teacher meetings, aspects of your child's education. Here you also be able to log out of the system. Here you can even be redirected to the Unikum website to get a better overview. Sometimes you may be asked to log in again; this is a security feature to ensure that only you will have access to your child's information.
