



## Guide for parents and guardians to itslearning


To log in as a parent or guardian, go to skolportalen.helsingborg.se




You can log in using BankID, Freja eID+ or with username and password



Once you have accessed Skolportalen you will want to choose itslearning.




Once you have logged into itslearning you will be on your own unique Parents Portal page. For those of you with more than one child you can toggle between their individual pages via your personal menu.





Depending on which gymnasieskola your child attends, information on the page may differ. These are some of the headlines you can expect to find:

Händelser (events): The events scheduled for the courses that your child participates in.



**Uppgifter (Tasks and Assignments):** Assignments that your child has already completed (Slutförda) or that is coming up (Aktiva). Parents and guardians can see the instructions and manner of assessment, but you can never see your child's answer.






## **Developmental Review (Utvecklingssamtal)**

Here you will find all published documents pertaining to your child's review by following the link. Note that you can see a subject's given assessment by clicking on No Current Plan, if the mentor has not yet published their review.

Once you have clicked on **Developmental Review** you will be able to see all the published information regarding your child.

Should there be no documents it will still be possible to see any published assessment that their teacher(s) have uploaded. If your child has had previous reviews it is possible to see those and the dates in which they were published.





Assessments are set on a three-point scale. Your child's teacher may explain this scale and its implications through comments and notes. There may also be a self-assessment your child has done themselves where they reflect on their own confidence and competence in the given subject.
